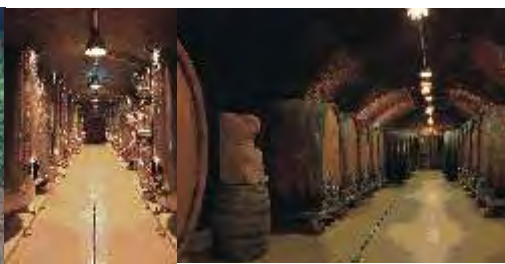
HEILIGENSTEIN Riesling 2007

Soil ----- Perm, Sandstone with volcanic elements
 Trainingssystem ----- Gyome
 Vineyard size ----- 2,5 ha

 Harvest ----- 2nd of November 2007
 Fermentation ----- Stainless steel

Wine description: Fruit clear as a bell, yellow gooseberries and physalis, full-bodied and deep; fine lines, at the same time extremely elegantly interwoven and filigree, playful and nervy with a long finish, good prospects. (VINARIA)

VINTAGE 2007 - After a warm winter vegetation started early at the beginning of April. Due to frost on May 1st we suffered severely in certain vineyards. Flowering went quickly in the beginning of June. The rest of the vegetation period was very hot and dry, which ended only in September with the long sought after rain. The beginning of main harvest was third week in October for the classical, light and crisp Veltliners. Riesling followed in the last week of Oktober and first week of November. The rest of November we were busy for the single vineyard GV's and selecting grapes for sweetwines. Icewine was harvested this year in two steps: first on December 19th and then again on Februar 19th.

SCHLOSS GOBELSBURG is the oldest winery in the Danube region with a documented history back to 1171. Since January 1996 the Château and winery is managed by family Michael Moosbrugger. The vineyards from the 35 ha estate are located on the slopes and terraces of the oldest vinyard sites around Langenlois. Nowadays the winemakers are interested in producing authentic and noble wines from different terroirs. The winery concentrates mainly on Grüner Veltliner and Riesling and in the selection of old authentic varieties.
